

An accurate count of district residents, including all adults and children of any age in each household, ensures that we receive appropriate funding for our programs. Additionally, census data is used to forecast growth and development in the district. These forecasts are used for budget planning, staffing, construction, and the determination of appropriate attendance boundaries for the schools.

Please help us today by filling out all sections on the attached census form and returning to the Student Information Services department. It is easy to return—simply fold it, tape as shown, and drop it in the U.S. mail -- no postage necessary. Your assistance in providing updated census information is greatly appreciated!

Note: Please be sure to fill in all of the requested information. The data provided will be used for school district purposes only and will not be shared with others.

- **Section 1:** List head of household with gender, birth date, home phone, cell and work phone, appropriate address and date moved into dwelling.
- **Section 2:** List additional head of household if applicable and all information requested.
- **Section 3:** List all others who live in your residence, including pre-school children, older children, and adults. Include all applicable information.
