

ADULT HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

I. Entrance Requirements

- A. Students must be 16 years of age or older.
- B. Students must not be currently enrolled in any other state supported educational program.
- C. Students must not have attended a regular day high school program for 100 continuous days prior to enrollment unless his class has graduated.

II. Acceptance of Credits

- A. Students meeting the above requirements will be eligible to earn a diploma from:
 1. a consortium high school serving the school district (191, 192, 194, 196) in which they reside, or,
 2. from the last high school attended within the consortium area.
- B. Credits may be earned for transfer to high schools outside the consortium area with the written agreement of acceptance of such credits by the school which will award the diploma.
- C. Students 19 years of age and under may earn up to five (5) semester credits in the Dakota Northwest Adult Diploma Program for graduation from Lakeville High School.
- D. Students 20 years of age and over may earn credits necessary for graduation from a consortium high school as determined by agreement between the consortium coordinator and the high school principal.

III. Procedures

- A. Prospective Adult Diploma Program students must:
 1. Register with the Dakota Northwest AB/CE Program Coordinator.
 2. Secure from the appropriate secondary principal a signed recommendation form which includes:
 - a. Confirmation of support of the student's enrollment in the Adult Diploma Program.
 - b. A description of credits needed by the student to complete graduation requirements.
 - c. Agreement that credits earned in the Adult Diploma Program will be accepted by the graduating high school.
- B. Students must adhere to all other appropriate Adult Diploma Program policies regarding attendance and grading.
