PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IN CURRICULUM-CONTENT REVIEW/OBJECTION

District 194 shall establish a procedure for a parent, guardian, or an adult student, eighteen years or older, to review the content of the instructional materials to be provided to a minor child or an adult student. Said procedure shall provide the parent the opportunity to register objection to the content of instructional material and to make reasonable arrangements with the District for alternative instruction.

Alternative instruction offered by the District shall be essentially equivalent to that provided as part of the adopted curriculum, with the learning expectations and evaluation processes clearly stated. Alternative instruction may be provided by the parent, guardian, or adult student if the alternative instruction offered by the District does not meet the concerns of the parent, guardian, or adult student.

The District is not responsible for costs of alternative instruction by a parent, guardian, or adult student. The District shall offer State Board of Education required curriculum as part of the alternative education presented to the student.

The District shall not impose an academic or other penalty upon a student for arranging alternative instruction in accord with the policy. The District may evaluate and assess the quality of the student's work.
