

STUDENT MANAGEMENT POLICY

Students are the first concern of the District and must receive the primary attention of the Board and all staff members. One of the major goals of the educational program shall be to assist each student in becoming self-sufficient learners and responsible citizens. To this end, the District shall establish written student management policies and procedures, appropriate for elementary and secondary level students, whose goal is to establish an environment conducive to the self actualization of these goals.

These student management policies and procedures shall be written and approved by the Board prior to the beginning of each school year. The approved student management policies and procedures shall be communicated to parents and students.

As a minimum, the student management policies and procedures shall address the following topics:

- student attendance
- student conduct and safety
- student discipline policy
- student exclusion/expulsion
- data privacy rights--release of student information
- student records policy
- chemical awareness policy/procedures
- child abuse/neglect reporting procedures
- corporal punishment
- equal educational opportunity/procedures for discrimination complaints
- sexual harassment and sexual violence policy

Student management policies and procedures may change as a result of Board policy, legislative mandate or judicial ruling during the school year. Such changes shall be communicated to students and parents as appropriate.
