Please read over the following important information with your child.

Personal Equipment/Clothing: If your student is bringing their equipment or a bag of snow gear to school, they can drop it off in the art room (120-1) before school.

Students must check in with an advisor to pick up their snack, lift ticket and rental form if needed. If they have a season pass and only need transportation, please still check in so we know who is with us each week.

Supervision: A CMS advisor will be in rental area to assist students and help them get to their lessons. Lessons meet outside the rental building on the snow by the large bell.

A CMS, MMS or KMS advisor will be in the main chalet from 2:45-5:30. All adults leave at 5:30 p.m. Please have a way to contact your child and arrange a time and place for pick up.

Students must be picked up by 5:30 p.m. or have permission to stay longer, however, there is no longer an CMS advisor at the hill.

Food: A small snack will be provided. Feel free to bring personal snacks or money if needed.

Personal Belongings: Your bag can go anywhere, however, it not 100% safe unless locked in a pay locker. We have over 100 CMS kids in Ski/Snowboard Club; It is impossible to watch each student's belongings. Please have a plan with your child, so they know where to store their equipment and/or bag while they ski/board. Possible options include pay lockers, the rental building storage shelves, under a table in chalet or in back room. Students could also leave their backpack at CMS and pick up on way home.
