Question 1 on the ballot includes a request for \$100,000 per year for 10 years to enhance and sustain safety and security measures throughout Lakeville Area Public Schools.



How would approval of this capital levy support learning?

Providing a safe and welcoming learning environment for our students is essential to ensure the success of every student. Our students need and deserve to feel secure and comfortable as they strive for excellence.

We have partnered with our community experts, including the Lakeville Police and Fire Departments, to develop a comprehensive plan to address the safety concerns of the world we live in today. We have made significant strides to improve our security across the district by implementing pieces of this plan. But we need your support to improve our capability to best protect our students and staff. A dedicated funding source for security measures would allow the district to improve safety and security systems at all schools through access control and visitor management systems, automatic door locks in cases of perimeter lockdowns, and vital security cameras. These security measures will help Lakeville Area Public Schools reach the next level of security in our district for our students, families, and staff.



If approved, capital funding would support:

Visitor Management

Provide support for systems to:

- Enhance access control and visitor management systems
- Support and sustain security systems
- Track and monitor visitors to our buildings

Internal Security

Enhance lockdown abilities by:

- Installing electric strikes for automatic door locks
- Providing a single button lockdown capability at buildings
- Enhancing the ability to lock down sections of the building when needed

Security Cameras

Support additional security through:

- Enhanced video monitoring throughout the buildings
- Video footage to identifying and resolve issues as they arise
- Deterrence of potential threats and/or intruders
