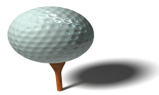

The golf team is for 6th-8th grade boys and girls. All skill levels are welcome and our coaches will work with students to improve the player's overall game.

Practices start on Tuesday, April 2, at McGuire Middle School. KTMS/ CMS students will take the shuttle bus to MMS the first week, M.-Th. There will be a parent meeting Thu, April 4, 4:30 at MMS. The rest of the season will take place at Cleary Lake GC, M.-F. from 3:00-5:00 p.m. That date will depend solely on the weather and when CLRP can open the course. Golfers will take a shuttle bus to Cleary, parents will pick golfers up at Cleary after practice.

We will have three teams of equal numbers of golfers, CMS Black, KTMS White, MMS Maroon. Golfers should bring tennis shoes or golf spikes, rain gear and must have their own golf clubs and transport them to school each morning. Clubs cannot be taken on the route buses.

6th - 8th grade Track and Field serves as an introduction to the sport. Regardless of athletic ability, there is an event for every athlete. We offer 8 events on the track and 4 in the field. Practices will start on Tuesday, April 2.

New for the program this year, there will be two track teams, one that feeds LNHS and one that feeds LSHS. The CMS/KTMS (north) team will practice at Kenwood M.-F. from 2:15-4:15. The KTMS/MMS (south) team will practice after school at McGuire M.-F. from 3:00-5:00.

Century students will take the shuttle bus after school to Kenwood. Kenwood South students will take the shuttle bus after school to McGuire.

There will be two separate schedules for each team.

Because of limited court space, participation will be first come, first serve. You must complete registration on FeePay before the start of the season.

Practices are Monday – Friday starting on Tuesday, April 2, right after school for about 1-1/2 hours. The goals of this group are to improve tennis skills, compete against other schools, have fun and exercise. Tennis is for boys in 6-8 grade.

Athletes should bring a tennis racquet and wear tennis attire the first day.

7th and 8th graders, with tennis experience may try out for the varsity teams at the high schools. Contact the high schools for tryout information and requirements prior to our middle school season.

ELIGIBILITY REMINDER

To participate in Middle School Sports, the athlete must have a valid sport's physical on file in the school's health office. You will not be able to complete your child's registration on FeePay without this on file. You can check your parent portal for the sport's physical date. If there is not a date listed, there is not one for your child on file. The sport's physical paperwork is available on the website and at each middle school. You will also need to attach your child's school I.D. number which is also found on parent portal.
